

CUSTOMERS OF WONEWOC LIGHT AND WATER WORKS

Wonewoc Light and Water Works has filed an application with the Public Service Commission of Wisconsin (PSC) to increase electric rates. The adjustment is necessary in order to upgrade and maintain the utility's electric distribution system, and to cover inflationary increases in operation and maintenance expenses that will allow the utility to continue providing reliable and quality service to our customers. The last electric rate increase was approved in May 2010.

The requested rate increase is detailed in Wonewoc Light and Water Works' electric rate application submitted to the PSC on January 27, 2022. After review, Commission staff proposed an increase in rates of \$100,992 or 19.26%. The actual change to individual customer will vary with electricity usage, class of service, and the final rates authorized by the Commission. If the application is approved by the PSC, per staff recommendation, the average residential customer using 572 kilowatt-hours (kWh) of electricity per month will see a monthly increase of approximately \$14.99 or 22.54%.

An audiovisual hearing on the application has been scheduled for Wednesday, August 3, 2022 at 10:00 a.m. This virtual hearing has no physical location at PSC's office in Madison, WI.
